The Hunting Tests are run under the rules and guidelines of the Hunting & Working Airedales, Inc. A copy may be obtained at <http://huntingworkingairedales.org/HWIncRegs.pdf>

For those entered in the Hunting Tests there will be no training on the grounds. No whips, prong collars, electronic collars or abuse of dogs will be tolerated. Entrants found with such devices or observed abusing their dog will be dismissed with no return of entry fees. Bark Collars in vehicles OK.

For those entered in the Workshops, a 30' - 50' rope or lead can be a helpful training tool. You may want to bring one along.

Rescued Airedales are welcome.

Hunting attire -In keeping with the aim of simulated hunting conditions and situations, handlers, Judges, workers and other Test participants shall be attired in customary hunting attire which adequately reflects the hunting environment. (i.e. some blaze orange for the upland test, dark or camo for the retriever test)

Bitches in season. Shall not be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the grounds. Scratches will be accepted for bitches in season and for injury or illness when a veterinary certificate is presented. Entry fees will be refunded after a deduction of \$15.00 for club expenses.

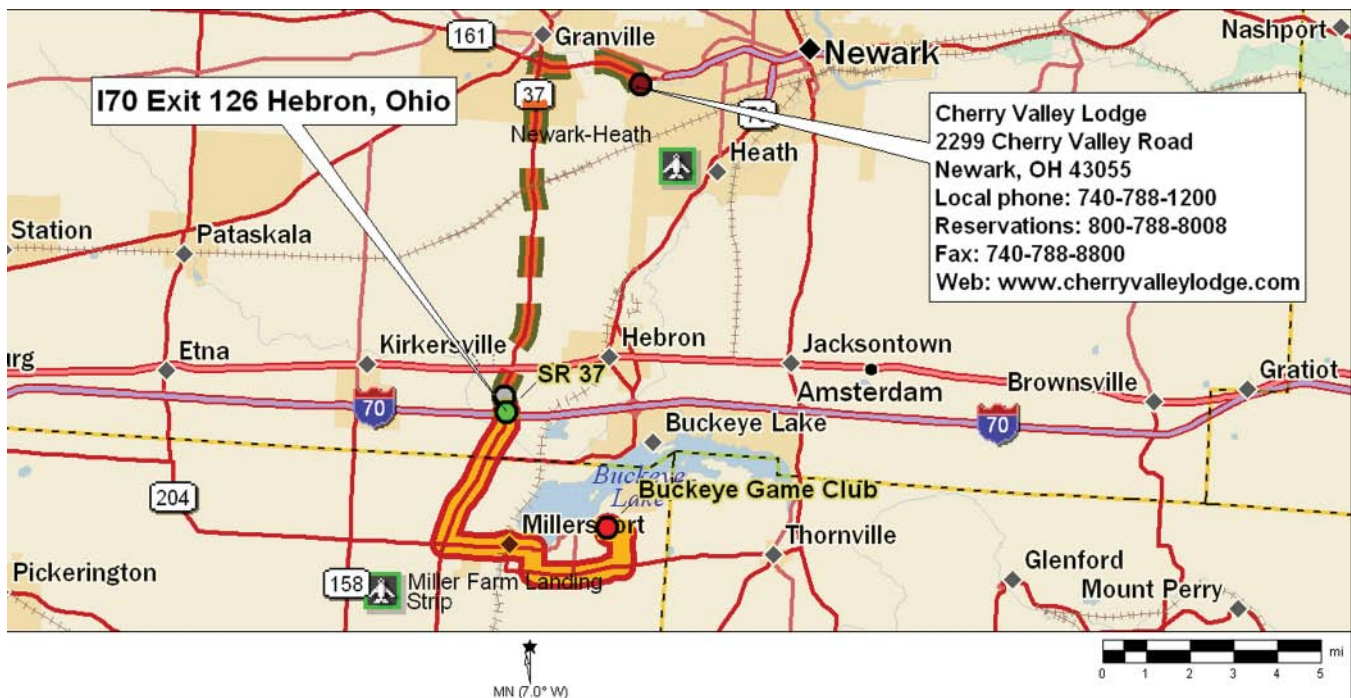

Hunt Test Rule Changes and Frequently Asked Questions

The Hunting Working Airedales would like you to keep two rules in mind as you register.

Test Level Entry:

Entries are restricted to one level per dog per test component, with the following exception: if a dog passes a test component at a level not previously passed (at the Nationals only), he may be moved up to the next test level in that component. For example: if a dog with no fur test title is entered in the junior fur test and he passes, the owner may then enter and run him in the senior test at this event. However, if a dog with a junior hunter-fur title is entered in the junior test and passes, he may not also run the senior test. This entry restriction applies at all test levels. A "component" means a test type - the components are fur tracking/trailing, upland/flushing, and retrieving.

Retrieving Title Requirement

At the junior level, a dog must perform two single (marks) retrieves on land and two on water. A dog entered in the Upland/flushing test must perform 1 single mark (retrieve) in the water series.

Frequently Asked Questions

Must I pay for a workshop if I am not bringing a dog?

Observers without dogs are welcome at the workshops, but they will have to pay the same workshop fee as those who bring dogs.

Do I have to pay for a workshop if I have entered a hunt test?

Yes. Workshops are offered as alternative events requiring separate entry fees and registration.

May I enter a hunt test if I have never entered a hunt test or workshop?

Yes you may enter a hunt test without entering a workshop. Copies of HWA hunt test regulations may be obtained by contacting Dorothy Miner at dmminer@watchtv.net or 419-647-4626.

What topics will the workshop cover?

The workshop will cover the basics in how to train your dog for the various hunt tests and hunting situations.

May I scratch my dog after entering a hunt test or workshop?

You may scratch your dog for any reason. However in order to get a refund, you must obtain a signed vet's certificate stating the dog is not healthy enough to compete.

How do I register for just the water tests?

The water tests are for those who have registered for and passed the land portion of the Upland or Retrieving tests.

Is a water test required for an upland/flushing title?

Yes. Dogs entered in the upland/flushing (or pointing when applicable) tests must also pass the water series of the retrieving test.

Do I have to enter my upland/flushing dog in the retriever test in order to run the required water retrieve series for upland dogs?

No. If your dog is entered in the upland/flushing test, he is automatically included in the water series. However, if you wish to enter the retrieving test as well as the upland in order to earn both titles, you would have to enter both tests.
